

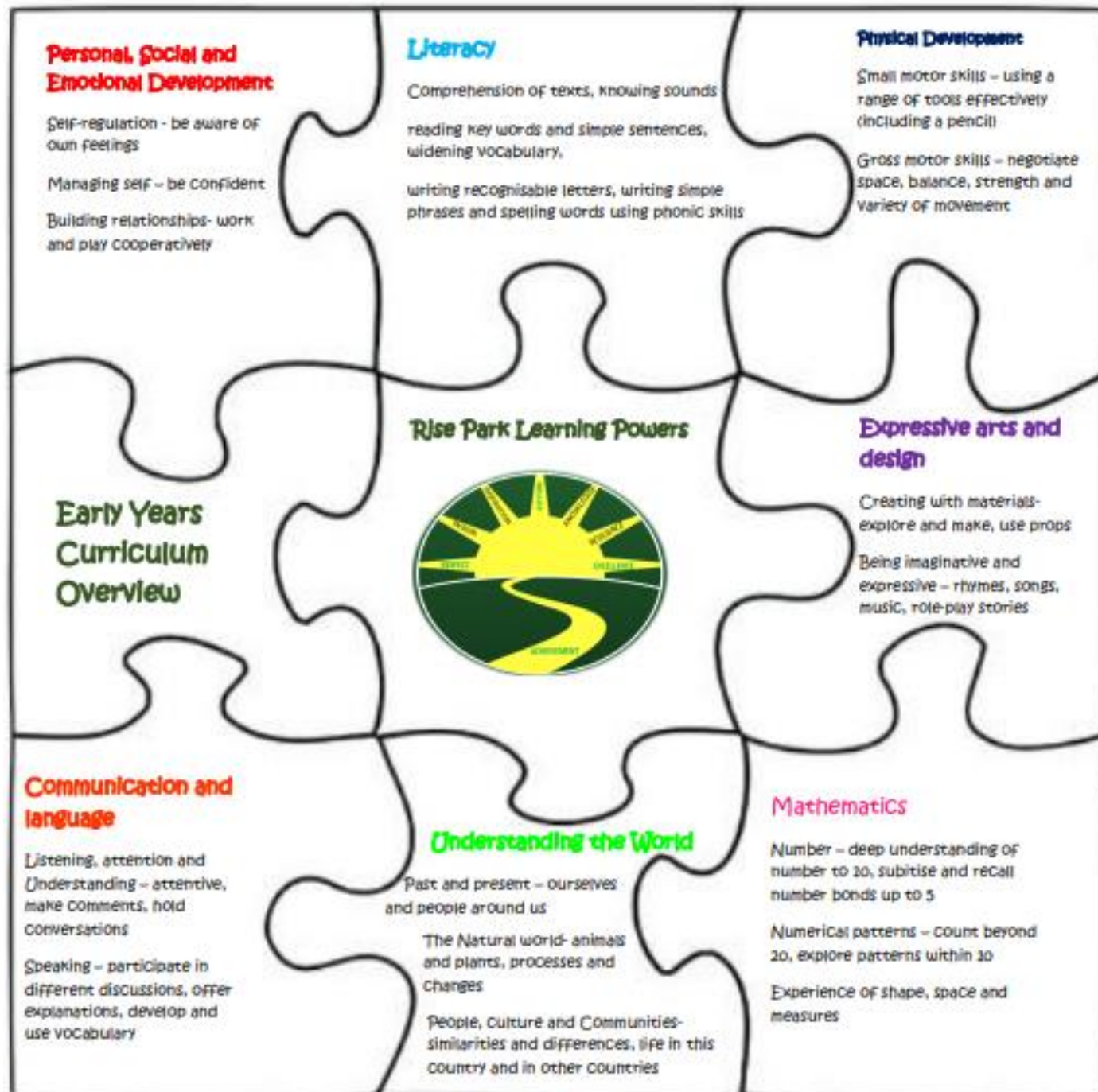

Inside the Reception Centre

We are a purpose built, semi-open plan building. We have 3 classroom areas and shared areas. Each classroom has an interactive whiteboard, small library area, carpet area, and work spaces.

The shared areas include a library area and several role play opportunities.



The grounds around the building

We are very lucky to have a large outdoor area for exclusive use of the Reception Centre. We have a covered area which is used all year round. In addition to this we have a hard surface area, a small field and a garden area. The garden area includes opportunities for role play, reading, exploring nature, sand and water play, a mud kitchen, den making and physical development using a large pirate ship, a small climbing A frame and items to make obstacle courses.



When your child starts school it would be helpful if he/she could do these things:

Preparing for school

There are a number of ways in which you can help your child prepare for school.



take off their coat and hang it up



put on their coat and fasten it



change their shoes



dress and undress



use a handkerchief



use a knife and fork



use the toilet properly and flush it



wash and dry hands



share toys and take turns

My day at Rise Park.



- When we arrive on a morning we put our school book bag away, our water bottle on the table and hang our coats up. You will have your own coat peg with your name. Then we will sit on the carpet and take the register. After that we are ready to start activities. We will learn our sounds and letters and learn to count and recognise numbers. We will work on holding our pencils correctly and have lots of things to choose to do. We will have a drink (water in your bottle or a carton of milk) and a piece of fruit (provided by school). After that, we are back to exploring and learning.



- When it is lunchtime we will wash our hands and eat lunch - packed lunch from home or a school dinner.
- We will continue exploring and learning - inside the classroom and outside too.
- Some days we will wear our special school P.E. uniform and use our P.E. equipment.
- During the day we will listen to stories and have plenty of time to make lots of friends.
- Remember all the grown ups will help you if you are unsure of anything - just ask us to help.

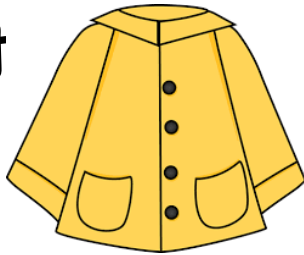
