

# Year 6

## Summer Term 2020

## Mathematics

#### Summer 1:

The children will be covering a wide range of topics and practising a variety of different style questions. They will also be increasing their understanding of data handling and maths patterns.

## Summer 2:

The children will be increasing their understanding of: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division of fractions; decimals and percentages; the four number operations; ratio and proportion; algebra; volume of cubes and cuboids; positions in all four quadrants of a grid and translations and reflections.

## Summer 1 and 2:-

The children will be exploring a range of genres, including: informal letter writing, instructions, non-chronological reports and recounts.

The children will also be continuing grammar, punctuation and spelling activities across the term.

Reading activities will also continue.

The children will learn new skills, techniques and tactics which can be applied to sport scenarios and games. The children will become more competent learners and will gain more confidence and a better understanding of Striking and Fielding.
