Learning through play is a key part to our Early Years Programme. We encourage learning through play within the classroom and in the outdoor classroom.

The outdoor classroom offers the opportunity for children to -

- explore and investigate with all their senses.
- become deeply involved and concentrate for long periods of time.
- revisit the same concept in a variety of ways.
- develop creatively and imaginatively using different materials and resources.
